**Dylan Brady/
designed a green haven**

Brady, of Studio505, designed the greenest building in Australia: the Pixel office building on the CUB site on Swanston Street; it scored 100 out of 100 in its green-star rating plus a perfect five for innovation.

Brady says it is "a bit of a laboratory", collecting its own water, harvesting biogas from sewage for hot water and harnessing energy from wind turbines and solar panels.
